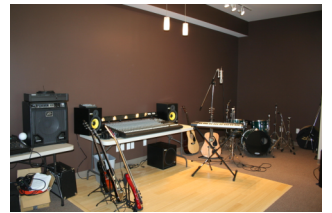

Barefoot Republic Camp is set upon 110 acres on the Barren Lake outside of Scottsville, Kentucky. We welcome all those who seek to get away and enjoy a place of beauty, refreshment and reflection. The camp is available for weekend retreats and week-long activities, such as summer youth camps or corporate retreats.

### **AMENITIES**

- Two treehouse villages and conditioned barn that sleep up to 150 people. Each treehouse village has 3 adjoining cabins that are heated and air-conditioned with 4 private showers, 4 sinks and 3 toilets. The loft in the barn is also conditioned.
- A multipurpose center building with a fully-equipped, commercial kitchen, full bathroom, cafeteria-style seating for 150, corporate meeting space for 100, two classrooms and a recording studio.
- Other amenities include an amphitheater seating up to 225, low-ropes course, 9-hole Disc Golf course, wiffle ball field, full court basketball, skate park and paintball field. Guests will also have access to hiking trails, open fields and woods, a spring-fed creek and access to Barren River Lake.



### **RATES**

Friday & Saturday:

Rate: \$28/person/night

Sunday thru Thursday:

Rate: \$23/person/night

Please note there is a \$900 minimum per night.

Day Rate: \$10/person or a \$300 minimum per day.

Please note there is an extra cost for use of the cabins.

Lake House – may be rented for additional housing at \$150 per night

*Deposit:* \$500 due upon signing of contract to secure dates. Deposits are fully refundable if cancellations are made 90 days in advance.

### **GENERAL FACILITY USE INFORMATION**

#### **HEALTH & PERSONAL SAFETY**

Barefoot Republic Camp is a smoke-free environment.

No drugs or other controlled substances are permitted.

Firearms, weapons of any kind, and fireworks are prohibited.

Campfires may only be built with permission of the Director and only in designated areas. All fires must be monitored and put out before leaving the area.

Guests should be aware that the property is a nature filled setting with inherent risks such as poison ivy, tree roots & limbs, rough terrain, mosquitoes, ticks, etc.

Barefoot Republic Camp is not responsible for lost or stolen personal items.

Guests are requested to park their vehicles in the gravel parking lot for the duration of their stay.

Medical services are not available on site. If desired, guests should provide their own currently certified CPR/First Aid personnel and medical supplies for their group.

Barefoot Republic Camp does not furnish camper/guest/retreat group insurance. Each group should check with their sponsoring authority regarding coverage for off site activities.

Thermostats should never be set: Above 73 for heat  
Below 68 degrees for AC

Please make sure that all windows and doors are kept closed during use of the heat and air.

### **CHECK-IN PROCEDURES**

After submission of contract and security deposit, a member of our staff will contact you about further details of your arrival. A staff member will meet you at the facility to assist with your check-in unless other prior arrangements are made in advance.

### **CHECK-OUT PROCEDURES**

Help us keep the camp clean. Trash should be picked up around the camp and within all buildings used during your stay and placed in the dumpster prior to leaving. Trash bags, brooms, mops and cleaning supplies are provided in the closet off of the dining hall.

Before leaving:

Please close all doors and windows

Turn off all lights (inside and out)

Make sure all water faucets are off

Thermostats—Set at 78 if using the AC and 60 if using the heat

### **INVOICE AND PAYMENT**

Barefoot Republic Camp will invoice each group based on reservations and/or usage. Invoices are to be made payable to Barefoot Republic Camp and we request all payments be within 30 days upon receipt of invoice. If there are no damages, the \$500 deposit will be put towards your final payment.

### **FOOD SERVICE & CATERING**

The commercial kitchen is available by groups renting the facilities for no additional charge. The kitchen includes 2 fryers, large grill, oven, tilt skillet, mixer, steamer, ice maker (snow

cone ice!), refrigerator, freezer, pots, pans and utensils. The tree-house also has a large gas grill available.

Barefoot Republic Camp is also happy to provide food service for you. However, this would generally require a minimum cost of \$4.50/person for breakfast, \$5.50/person for lunch and \$7.50/person for dinner. Please note that pricing may fluctuate based upon the menu desired. If interested, please contact us for more information.

## **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

**Does our group need to have individuals sign a hold harmless agreement and/or medical waiver?** No. However, we do ask that if you are part of an organization, such as a church, school, etc., that you provide proof of insurance for off-site activities.

**Can we build a bonfire?** Yes. We have a couple of designated sites for bonfires. If available, wood may be collected on site or groups may bring their own.

**Are paper products available?** Yes. Barefoot Republic provides all toilet paper and paper towels. However, we ask that each group bring their own paper plates, cups and utensils if not utilizing our food services.

**Do Barefoot Republic Camp staff live on site?** No. However, our facilities director lives outside of Scottsville and is on call for any needs that may arise. His contact information is included in our welcome packet for groups renting the facility.

**What are best places to stop between Nashville and Barefoot Republic Camp for fuel and meals?** We recommend stopping for fuel off of exit #2 or exit #6 right after you enter Kentucky. These exits have the cheapest fuel. Exit #2 has a Cracker Barrel, Zaxby's and Burger King. Exit #6 has a Wendy's and Subway. We also recommend grabbing a meal in Scottsville on the way to the camp. Earl G. Dumplins is on the way and our favorite spot! There is also Alpine Steakhouse & Harper's Catfish if you want local cuisine. Or, you can always stop at Pizza Hut, Subway, China King or the local Mexican restaurant. Finally, if you are craving a candy bar, drink, sandwich or need gas in a pinch, you can visit Ms. Ann at Notley & Ann's Bait Shop, which is located less than a ¼ mile from the camp. Please tell Ms. Ann that Tommy sent you!

**What type of audio/visual equipment is available?** We have a small PA that is available for no additional charge. We also have additional equipment and instruments in our recording studio that may be utilized, but we do ask that you make prior arrangements and handle all of the equipment that we utilize for camp with care! There is also a projector available.

**Do you have paint ball equipment?** Yes. We own 12 Tippmann 98 paint ball guns. These are available to rent for \$10 per day per gun, which also includes CO2 refills (tank on campus). We also supply paint balls at cost (\$40/box and 2,000 paintballs in a box). We do require that you use our paint for our guns to help us preserve the life of our equipment. Please feel free to bring your gear if you would like to play as well, but make prior arrangements so we can insure that the trails and field are prepared in advance for your group.

**Can our group use the low ropes course?** Yes. We currently have 8 initiatives on the low ropes course (trust fall, wild woody, single-line traverse, Mohawk walk, climbing wall, all aboard, spiders web and fireman's chute). We encourage each group to bring their own facilitators, but we also have a list of folks available (fees vary based upon the facilitator).

**Can our group utilize the recording studio?** Yes. The recording studio may be utilized for an additional \$200/day. However, we do require the presence of an approved engineer. If interested, please make prior arrangements. Barefoot Republic also has a list of available engineers (additional fees vary based upon the individual).

**What is your alcohol policy?** If you would like to bring alcoholic beverages on site, you must send us a copy of your insurance policy with Barefoot Republic Camp listed as being additionally insured.

**Can we bring more than 150 people on our retreat?** YES. We have had groups squeeze more than 150 folks into the tree-house cabins, barn and multipurpose building. The numbers we list, however, are what we would recommend. The lake house may also be rented separately for additional accommodations (see below). Groups are also welcome to bring tents for outdoor camping and there is 1 RV hookup located on campus.

**Is there a private place for a guest speaker, pastor, family, etc. to stay?** YES. We can set up one of the classrooms in the multipurpose building as a private bedroom (full bath in the basement) and there is also a lake house that may be rented for an additional charge on property adjacent to the camp. The lake house sleeps up to 16. Camp rates apply and there is a minimum nightly fee of \$150 per night.

**How many people can the Sparrow Amphitheater accommodate?** Our current arrangement can seat ~125. However, we have an additional 100 outdoor chairs that may be utilized for groups up to 225.

## **DIRECTIONS TO OUR FACILITIES**

Barefoot Republic Camp is located on Barren River Lake in Fountain Run, Kentucky

Our address is 8824 Brownsford Rd., Fountain Run, KY 42133.

### **From Nashville, TN (South of property)**

Estimated Time: 1:20

Estimated Distance: 75 miles

Take 65N for approximately 39 miles to Exit 6 (Franklin/Scottsville) in Kentucky.

Go right toward Scottsville on Hwy 100E for approximately 20 miles until you reach a dead end.

Take a left onto Old Gallatin Road (100E). Please note that you will cross New Gallatin Rd (Hwy 31) before reaching Old Gallatin Rd.

Go approximately 2 miles until you reach the Scottsville square (Dollar General on left).

Take a right onto E. Main (100E) and go approximately 1 mile until you reach the Hwy 3499 and Hwy 98 split.

Stay right taking Hwy 98 (Brownsford Rd) approximately 9 miles to Barefoot Republic Camp on the left.

Look for 8824 Brownsford Rd. We share a gravel road with 8830. Stay to your left and travel down the road to Barefoot Republic Camp. You can park anywhere on the gravel.

### **From Louisville, KY (North of property)**

Estimated Time: 2 hrs.  
Estimated Distance: 120 miles

Take I-65 S toward Nashville (83 mi)  
Take KY-90/KY-70 exit, Exit 53, toward Cave City/Glasgow (.3 mi)  
Left onto KY-70 (.2 mi)  
Stay straight to go onto Happy Valley St./Happy Valley Rd/KY -90. (9.9 mi)  
Right onto US-31E/KY-90. Continue to follow US-31E S. (13.7 mi)  
Left onto onto KY-87. (4.9 mi)  
Right onto Bradshaw Rd. (1.3 mi)  
Stay straight to go onto Charles Turner Rd. (1.7 mi)  
Right onto KY-921 (2.6 mi)  
Slight left onto KY-98 (1.2 mi)  
Look for 8824 Brownsford Rd. We share a gravel road with 8830. Stay to your left and travel down the road to Barefoot Republic Camp. You can park anywhere on the gravel.

**From Knoxville, KY (East of Property)**

Estimated Time: 3 hrs.  
Estimated Distance: 170 miles

Take I-40 E ramp toward Asheville. (.3 mi)  
Merge onto I-40 W via the exit on the left toward Nashville. (107.8 mi)  
Take TN-56 N exit, Exit 280, toward Baxter/Gainesboro (.2 mi)  
Right onto TN-56/Baxter Rd. Continue on TN-56. (17.6 mi)  
Slight left onto TN-56/TN-85. Continue on TN-135. (10.4 mi)  
Left onto Keeling Branch Hwy/TN-135. Continue on TN-135. (9.4 mi)  
Right to stay on TN-135. (.3mi)  
TN-135 becomes Clementsville KY Rd. (1.4 mi)  
Left to stay on Clementsville KY Rd. (2 mi)  
Clementsville KY Rd becomes KY-87. (1.8 mi)  
Left onto KY-100/KY-63?KY-87/Gamaliel Rd. Continue on KY-63/KY-87. (1.3 mi)  
Right onto KY-100/Fountain Run Rd. (14 mi)  
Right onto KY-98. (3.5 mi)  
Look for 8824 Brownsford Rd. We share a gravel road with 8830. Stay to your left and travel down the road to Barefoot Republic Camp. You can park anywhere on the gravel.

**From Memphis (West of property)**

Estimated Time: 4:30  
Estimated Distance: 300 miles

Take I-40 E toward Nashville. (13 mi)  
Merge onto I-40 E via Exit 12C on the left toward Nashville. (197.1 mi)  
Merge onto I-65 N via Exit 208B on the left toward Louisville. (2.1 mi)  
Merge onto I-65 N via Exit 86A on the left toward Clarksville/Louisville. (57.5 mi)  
Take Exit 22 toward KY-231/Bowling Green/Scottsville. (.3 mi)  
Right onto US-231 S/Scottsville Rd. (17.5 mi)  
US-231 S becomes KY -980/Veterans Memorial Hwy. (1.3 mi)  
Left onto KY- 100. (.4 mi)  
Right onto KY-100/KY-98/E Main St. (.3mi)  
Right onto KY-100/S 5<sup>th</sup> St. (.1 mi)  
Left onto KY-100. (6.1 mi)  
Left onto KY-671. (4.6 mi)  
Right onto KY-98. (1.5 mi)  
Look for 8824 Brownsford Rd. We share a gravel road with 8830. Stay to your left and travel down the road to Barefoot Republic Camp. You can park anywhere on the gravel.
